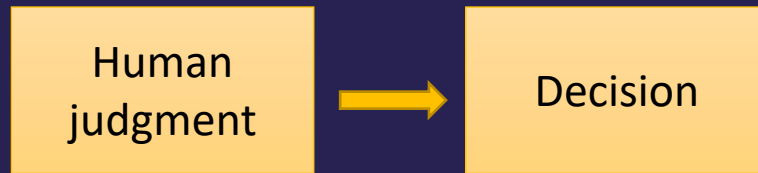

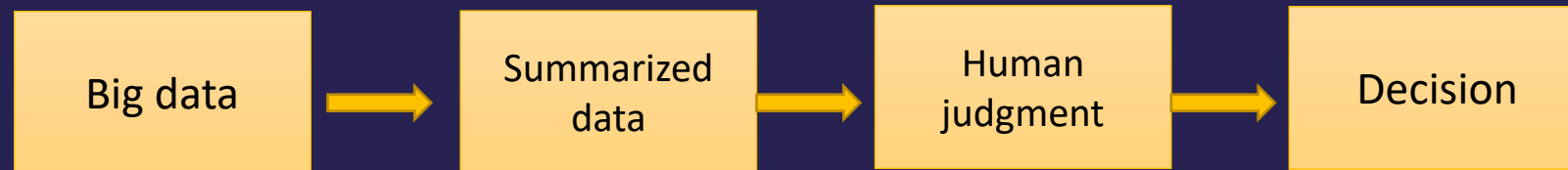


Decision models based on Colson's (2019) framework

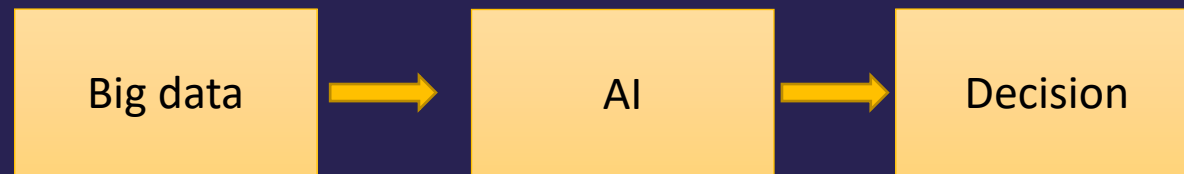
Decision making based on human judgement



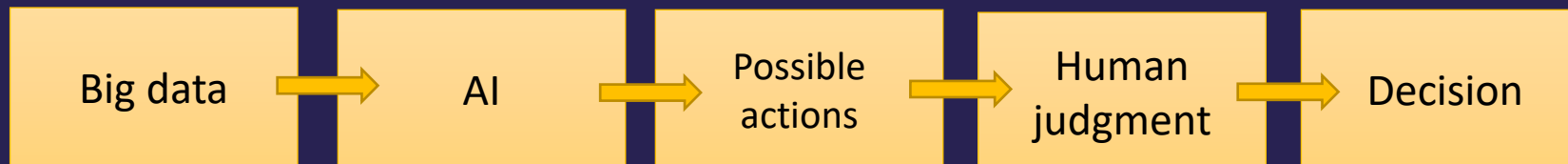
Decision making utilizing data

Recommendations and suggestions

We recommend to introduce the “E-law” electronic system

Necessary to cover the following tasks:

- To create legal basis
- To launch program support
- To train officials and other staff
- To deal with other organizational tasks

Amendments and adoption of new normative legal acts

1. The Law “On the Procedure for Preparing and Submitting Draft Laws to the Legislative Chamber of the Oliy Majlis of the Republic of Uzbekistan” (amendments to Article 4)
2. Adoption of joint resolution of the Legislative Chamber of the Oliy Majlis of the Republic of Uzbekistan

The priority tasks of the “E-law” electronic system (1)

- online submission;
- reflection of the chronological stages;
- online translation of the parliamentary discussions;
- public discussion of draft laws;
- real-time management, monitoring and control of all actions on the implementation of draft laws and resolutions;

The priority tasks of the “E-law” electronic system (2)

- obtaining, operation, storage, processing of all information;
- saving time, costs and labor resources spent;
- supporting the general public with information on legislative affairs;
- automatic formation of (monthly, yearly) rankings.
